

POSTER PRESENTATION REQUIREMENTS AND GENERAL INFORMATION

As the contact author, you are the only person receiving this information. In the event you do not plan to present this poster, please pass this material on to the speaker immediately.

Registration Information: IITC policy requires that all authors and speakers attending the conference must register and pay the registration fee by April 15, 2013 23:59 (GMT-0700) at <http://www.semiconportal.com/IITC2013/>. If you are unable to attend the conference, one of your co-authors may register and present the paper. If none of the authors are able to attend and present the paper, the paper will not be published on the IEEE xPlore website. (The registration site will be available from March 18, 2013)

Sessions/Time: Posters must be set-up on the day of presentation between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 9:30 a.m. and must be removed between 5:00 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. You should be at your poster to make presentations and answer questions during the Poster Session (1:00 p.m. – 2:30 p.m.). THE CONFERENCE IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR POSTERS WHICH ARE NOT REMOVED BY THE AUTHOR(S).

Visual Aids: Each poster will be assigned a 2.0 meter tall by 0.9 meter wide poster board. Your poster presentation should be designed so that it is self-explanatory, even when you are not there. You should prepare visual aids (charts, graphs, photos, etc.) and text explaining your presentation,

Preparation of Your Poster Presentation

1. Organize your presentation to complement, not duplicate your paper. Prepare graphic aids to assist you in explaining your topic. (Your paper submission will be published in the Conference Digest and your electronic version will be on the CD-ROM.)
2. Define your problem. What led to your work? What were your objectives? What were the advantages and disadvantages of your methods and devices?
3. Outline the course of your work, mentioning major features only!
4. Suggest applications, make recommendations.
